



Disabled parking can be found directly adjacent to the venue, in the Osborn Road and Ferneham Hall Pay and Display Car Parks. Blue Badge holders can park free provided the Blue Badge is clearly displayed in the vehicle.

There is also extensive disabled parking in the Osborn Road Multi-Storey Pay on Foot Car Park directly behind Ferneham Hall. However,

unless the Badge holder is a resident of Fareham, there will be a charge to park. Blue Badge holders who are Borough residents can apply to the Council for a swipe card allowing free entry and exit to the Pay on Foot car parks.

**F**areham's Ferneham Hall is committed to making a visit to the venue as accessible as possible for all its customers including those with disabilities. We are always trying to make improvements to our services. Comments from customers particularly those with disabilities are always welcome.



There is easy wheelchair access to all ground floor areas of Ferneham Hall and to the flat surface of the main auditorium. The building's flexible seating means that wheelchairs can easily be incorporated into a wide number of positions in the auditorium. Large groups are also welcome and special provision will be made for carers.

Wheelchairs that are wider and/or taller than standard ones often need special attention so that the comfort and vision of all patrons is catered for and that no gangways are blocked or restricted. To aid in stewarding it is important that full details of the type and size of wheelchair are given to the box office at the time of booking so that suitable provisions can be made in advance. Please allow ten minutes prior to the start of the performance so that staff have time to solve any problems which may arise. Wheelchair users do not have to be accompanied to visit Ferneham Hall.

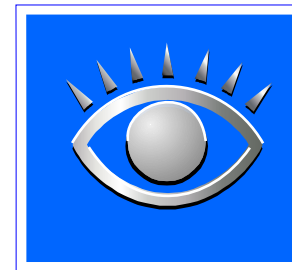
Though there are no discounted tickets for wheelchair users, an accompanying carer will be charged half the full price.



Unisex disabled toilet facilities are available in Ferneham Hall's main foyer. They are situated to the right of the main entrance as you enter the building through its front doors. Facilities include a spacious floor area for wheelchair users and/or accompanying carers, fold down support rail, low level sink, drier and mirror. An emergency call button is also available for patrons who get into difficulty whilst using the facilities.



Ferneham Hall's auditorium features an infra-red amplification system. Special receivers are required which are preferably reserved from the box office at the time of booking an event. We supply either headset or "necklace" receivers depending on whether you already have a hearing aid or not. A £5 refundable deposit will be payable when collecting the receiver. A traditional "T" loop system is available at the box office and Octagon.



Ferneham Hall offers large A4 black and white formatted copies of its brochure to partially sighted patrons. Please ask at the box office if you require one or email us on [boxoffice@fareham.gov.uk](mailto:boxoffice@fareham.gov.uk) for one to be sent to you free of charge. Guide Dogs are welcome in Ferneham Hall but please tell the box office prior to your visit so that we may make provision for your dog in the auditorium. Although there are no discounts for blind or partially sighted patrons, companions are charged at half the full price, if required.
